A Task Team was created at the last Greater Cape Town U3A Forum to investigate forming a national organisation (U3A South Africa). This will not affect the autonomy of existing U3As but will speak to government with one voice; represent U3A in this country in relation to international U3A; assist the development of new U3As in South Africa and Southern Africa.

This Task Team plans an "Indaba" or get-together in George next year from 16 to 20 April 2012. This event will be open to all U3A members nationally.
